



MEDICATION PACKAGING

For safety reasons – and in order to adhere to state law – students at EXPLO may not self-administer medication.

Non-Pill Form Medication

Please bring your child's non-pill form medication (in the original packaging) to the EXPLO Nurse's Station upon arrival at EXPLO this summer. You do not need to process non-pill prescriptions with Andrews Pharmacy.

Pill Form Medication

Partnership with Andrews Pharmacy

EXPLO requires families who live in the United States* to process all student prescription and non-prescription pill medications (taken regularly) with our pharmacy partner, Andrews Pharmacy.

**Students coming from outside the United States: Andrews Pharmacy does not fulfill prescriptions from doctors outside of the United States. Students living abroad should bring pill and non-pill form medications (in the original packaging) to the EXPLO Health Office upon arrival at EXPLO this summer.*

Once you have completed your medication information on CampDoc.com, EXPLO will contact you if your child's medication should be filled by Andrews. For any questions in the interim, contact EXPLO at medforms@explo.org or 781.762.7400.

Partnership with Andrews Pharmacy

Andrews will process pills in special blister packs and travel packs, allowing EXPLO nurses to safely and legally administer students' medication according to best practices. (In addition, Andrews will deliver the medication directly to the EXPLO Health Office.)

Your next step will be to create your Andrews Pharmacy medication profile online, to identify your child as an EXPLO student.

Ordering Medications From Andrews

EXPLO covers the processing fee associated with packaging your medication order. Families are only responsible for the cost of the medications or an insurance co-pay. There is no additional cost to EXPLO families for the Andrews packaging service.**

Please note that EXPLO does not share payment information with Andrews, so you will need to include your credit card information on your Andrews Profile for the cost of the prescription. Andrews will not charge you for anything before communicating with you. If you have any concerns, or would prefer to pay by a different method than credit card, please contact them directly.

***Medication ordered after May 15 may be assessed a late processing fee by Andrews.*

Getting Prescriptions To Andrews

To expedite the processing of prescription medication, please have your licensed prescriber send prescriptions/scripts directly to Andrews Pharmacy. Ask your physician to include DEA and NPI numbers on all prescriptions:
