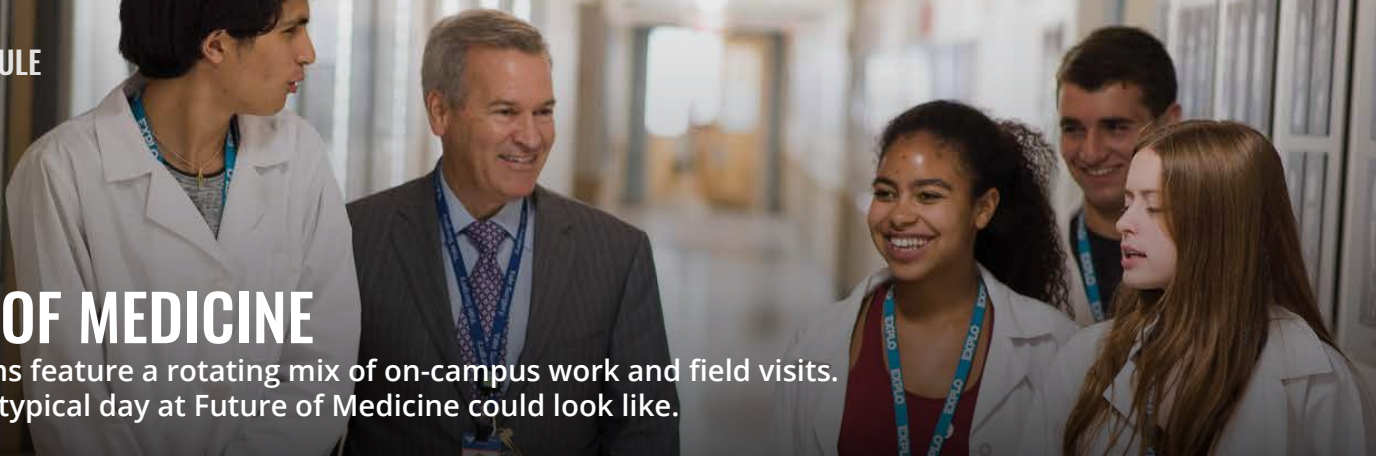


# FUTURE OF MEDICINE
